BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

Hartnell College Foundation submitted a proposal to build on the seed funding from the Claire Giannini Fund to partner with CSU Monterey Bay and local high schools to recruit and train students in a 2+2+2 cohort model in teaching careers with a preliminary focus on the South County population. Build a strong pool of talented educators following a "grow your own" approach, based on the principle that students are more likely to stay committed and support their community. Utilize an "incubator" type of approach by providing extra assistance, support services and a contextual environment focused on facilitating access, success and completion.
