This letter is in support of Hartnell's Nursing and Allied Health's proposal to extend its inter-professional clinical courses deep into the communities of Salinas and Salinas Valley. Hartnell's proposal would provide an ideal opportunity for nursing students to gain community-based healthcare provider skills. Under the direction of educators, students would apply concepts such as case management, community continuity of care, and cultural responsiveness necessary to meet the needs of diverse populations who live in rural settings and in underserved urban areas in the greater Salinas area.
